- Please include your first and last name, your date of birth, your primary place of residence, your contact number, and a signed and dated statement acknowledging that you agree to the Conditions of Entry.

- The entrant must acknowledge and comply with the following terms and conditions of entry in the "Unions NT May Day 2021 Poster Design Competition" (Competition);
- The entrant understands that all works completed and submitted to the Competition become the property of Unions NT and may be used and reproduced at Unions NT sole discretion at no charge.:
- This includes reproducing works for promotional purposes (i.e- on Unions NT social media pages, other media and any Unions NT publications).:
- The entrant acknowledges that all work must be their own original work
- The entrant acknowledges that any works submitted are not to contain offensive materials or materials likely to encourage discrimination in any form; otherwise those works and their authors will be disqualified from participation in the Competition.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF COMPETITION WINNER

- Unions NT will announce winner of the competition by 12:00pm ACST on Friday 2 April, 2021.
- The winner will take home a \$1,000 AUD cash prize, donated by Unions NT.
- Artwork will be assessed by a panel of judges against the criteria set out above. Given the participation requirements are met (including the Conditions of Entry, personal details provided etc.), the entrant with the highest numerical score wins the poster competition.
- In the event of a draw, the judge's panel will decide on a winner by consensus, or it will go to a vote.
- The successful poster will be distributed online and physically throughout the NT in the lead-up to May Day in order to promote the event.
- At the discretion of Unions NT, where possible and appropriate, the successful artist will receive verbal and/or written credit for their work, for their own personal and professional exposure.
